

Planning Examples

Children may choose how they wish to plan. Several different ways to plan writing should be taught across the school. This might start with the normal text box approach that complements length, detail and description, for children aged six and above. Very young children may just write single words in the frames or draw simple pictures, while older children may write phrases and sentences.

Other planning formats include cartoon strips, thought clouds, flowcharts, spider diagrams, or just making numbered notes.
