

## Instructions

Children should be taught to chant the common irregular verbs, or verbs that they often make mistakes with, between lessons or activities, or when lining up to leave the room.

They must be taught the meaning of *singular*, *plural*, *past* and *present* and especially the difference when *you* means one person and when *you* means two or more people.

This resource could be used on the whiteboard, as a display or as a handout.
